London, [6] May 2008 - In October 2008, Mike Stalley, founder and CEO of FiscalReps, will be putting on his hiking boots and taking part in one of the most spectacular and varied treks in the world, The Annapurna Experience in Nepal, to raise money for Macmillan Cancer Support.

The Annapurna Experience is new to the Macmillan Challenge portfolio and will take Mike and many other participants on a once-in-a-lifetime 11 day trek into the heart of this remote land. The route will take participants past fascinating temples and along unrivalled trekking trails to the awe-inspiring sight of the Annapurna Range. This series of peaks in the Himalayas has as its highest point Annapurna I, which stands at 8,091 metres and is the 10th highest summit in the world. The group will hike for up to nine hours a day and will be immersed in the wonders of Nepalese culture. The scenery will be forever changing, from local villages, alpine meadows and rhododendron forests to steep, craggy mountainsides.

“The Annapurna Experience will be a trip of a lifetime for me. I will be facing some of the most remarkable landscapes in the world,” said Mike. “It will be tough in parts and a personal challenge, but cancer is a disease that will affect all of us at some point in our lives and knowing I can make a difference and help people living with cancer makes my efforts all worthwhile.”

“In 2004 my father died from cancer. During his last few weeks he was cared for by Macmillan nurses who treated him with respect and dignity. They also gave a huge amount of support, both emotional and practical, to my mother and family, helping to ease the pain in what was a difficult and challenging time. I have seen at first hand the care and support Macmillan offers to people living with cancer, so I am taking part in the challenge to raise funds so that Macmillan can continue to help other families who find themselves in this position,” said Mike.

In the UK, one in three people will be diagnosed with cancer during their lifetime and over a million people are currently living with the disease. Macmillan is a UK charity providing expert care and practical and emotional support to those living with cancer. Money raised by Mike will be used to help fund specialist Macmillan nurses and doctors who deliver the best in cancer care, build vitally needed cancer care centres and give financial help to those who need it most.
